This competition has a Finals Competition with it. If we make finals, then the first band performs at 6:30 PM and the Awards are at 9:15 PM.

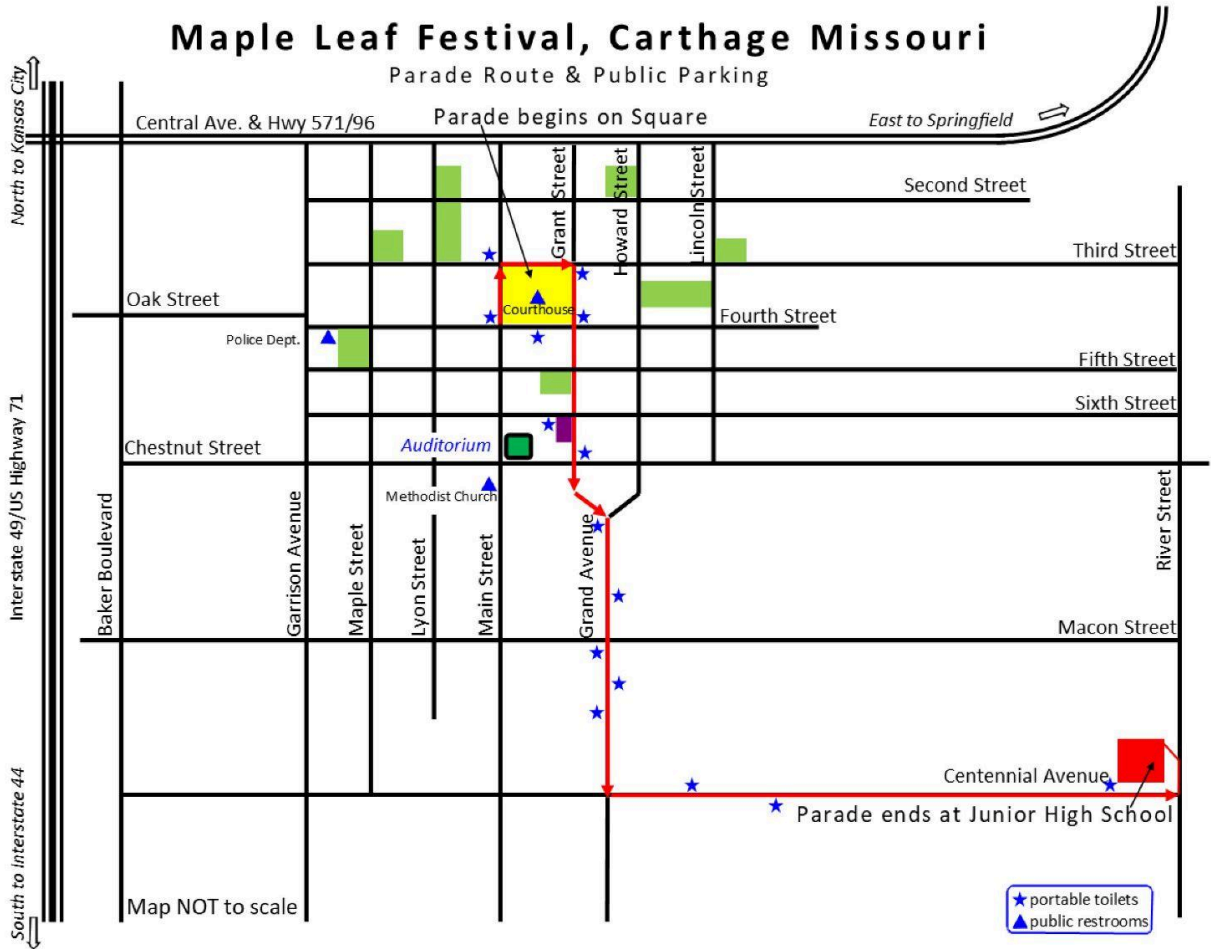

Parade route (lined in red) begins on the west side of the Square (in yellow), south down Grant/Grand Avenue, east on Centennial and ends at the Carthage Jr Hi School (River & Centennial). Total length is just under 2 miles. Handicap-accessible portable toilets and reserved seating for handicapped individuals located at 6th & Grant (in purple). Carthage R-9 Auditorium is located north of Chestnut & Main Streets.
